

BYLAW 2012-01

**A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF PARKLAND BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO ESTABLISH A NOXIOUS/RESTRICTED WEED BYLAW**

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach is responsible for control of its noxious/restricted weeds as directed by the Weed Control Act R.S.A. 2008, as amended to establish and maintain a Noxious/Restricted Weed Control Bylaw; and

WHEREAS it is desirable in the public interest, that such a Bylaw be established and maintained to carry out statutory powers and obligations under the said Weed Control Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF PARKLAND BEACH, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

SHORT TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Weed Control Bylaw".

1.0 DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw,

1. "Act" means the Weed Control Act, Chapter W-5.1, R.S.A. 2008;
2. "Council" means the Council of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach;
3. "C.A.O." means the Chief Administrative Officer for the Summer Village of Parkland Beach;
4. "Inspector" means a person or persons appointed by the C.A.O. to oversee and enforce the Weed Control Act within Village limits;
5. "Village" means the Summer Village of Parkland Beach.

2.0 GENERAL

Pursuant to the Act, Council hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Village will be governed by the Province of Alberta Weed Control Act.
2. The C.A.O will appoint Weed Control Officers for the purpose of enforcing the Act.

This Bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading.
