

**SUMMER VILLAGE OF PARKLAND BEACH
BYLAW NO. 2012-02
AMENDMENT TO THE TRAFFIC BYLAW 2011-03**

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF PARKLAND BEACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, permit a Council by bylaw to amend the Traffic Bylaw 2011-03, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach deems it necessary and expedient to amend the Traffic Bylaw 2011-03;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Section 2

Definitions

- j) "Highway" means any thoroughfare, street, road, trail, avenue, parkway, driveway, viaduct, lane, alley, square, bridge, causeway, trestle way or other place or any part of any of them, whether publicly or privately owned, that the public is ordinarily entitled or permitted to use for the passage or parking of vehicles and includes:
 - i) If a highway right of way is contained between fences or between a fence and one side of the roadway, all the land between the fences, or all the land between the fence and the edge of the roadway, as the case may be,

but does not include a place declared by regulation not to be a highway.

Section 3

Rules of the Road

- 3.3 No person shall park any vehicle on a highway within the Village for any purpose for longer than a maximum of 72 (seventy two) hours.
- 3.6 No person shall park any heavy vehicle on any highway or property within the Village unless a "special parking permit" has been obtained.
- 3.7 No person shall park or allow to be parked, any commercial vehicle which may be delivering goods or equipment to a lot, on any highway within the Village for a period exceeding 8 (eight) hours.
 - i) The vehicle must not block or impede traffic while parked on the highway;
 - ii) Appropriate safety signs must be placed around the vehicle parked on any highway.

Section 4

Miscellaneous

Construction equipment or vehicles

- 4.10 No person shall off and on load heavy equipment on Village highways without a permit issued by the Municipal Office.

Section 6

Road Restrictions

- 6.1 Road restrictions reduce allowable axle weights. All roadways within the Village are restricted to 75% at all times.
- 6.2 No person shall operated, or allow to operate in the Village, a vehicle over 75% without first obtaining a road permit from the Municipal Office.
- 6.3 During spring thaw and occasionally during extreme weather events, roads will be reduced to 50%, no road permits will be issued during these periods.
