

BY-LAW NO. 6

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF PARKLAND BEACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, RELATING TO THE CONTROL OF CAMPING IN PARKS AND ON RESERVE LANDS.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY of and pursuant to the provisions of the Planning Act, R.S.A. 1980, and amendments thereto, and the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1980 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach enacts as follows:

That all reserve lands registered in the name of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach are designated as parks.


That overnight camping in all parks is strictly prohibited and violations thereof are subject to prosecution.

This By-law shall come into force upon the date of third and final reading.


READ a first time this 17th. day of February, 1984.

READ a second time this 17th. day of February, 1984.

READ a third time and finally passed this 17th. day of February, 1984.
