

BYLAW NO. 2010-05

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF PARKLAND BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING THE GULL LAKE INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN, PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, BEING CHAPTER M-26 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS the Councils of, the Summer Villages of Parkland Beach and of Gull Lake, Ponoka County and Lacombe County recognized that the existing Gull Lake Management Plan adopted in 2000 required updating;

AND WHEREAS the preparation of the new Plan has been guided by a Committee made of elected officials from the four municipalities;

AND WHEREAS the new Intermunicipal Development Plan is designed to ensure a cooperative and coordinated policy framework is in place for managing the development and use of lands around Gull Lake;

AND WHEREAS notice was given of the intention of the four municipalities to adopt the new Plan in the following local newspapers:

AND WHEREAS a Joint Public Hearing was held on August 7, 2010 to allow the general public to comment on the proposed new Intermunicipal Development Plan;
