### STEPS to SECURITY

The RCMP have provided the following tips for crime prevention and reporting:

- Install an audible, loud, on-site alarm / Security cameras may also help
- When your home or cottage is vacant, remove valuables and other sought-after items such as liquor
- Make sure your property looks lived-in and have someone do regular check-ins if you are away
- Call RCMP right away when you see suspicious behaviour not hours later
- Do not give chase, but stay out of view when you call so the suspect is not alerted; and be cautious as they may be armed
- Neighbours walking around the community and watching out for each other is one of the most effective methods of crime prevention
- Join or support the local Gull Lake North COPS (Citizens on Patrol) it is a deterrent to crime
