### 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Parkland Beach Classic Hockey Tournament

Triangle Construction is hosting their 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual 4 on 4 Hockey Tournament on Sunday, February 19th, 2023, at the Summer Village of Parkland Beach.

Game times will depend on the number of teams entered, but should begin at 9 AM. The schedule will be posted in the Village Office window, at Jorgy's Hotspot, and on the Facebook group "2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Parkland Beach Classic Hockey Tournament", at least a week prior to the event.

Details are as follows:

- Format will be 4 on 4 with a fully equipped goalie. Players can wear whatever equipment they feel safe or comfortable in, but helmets are mandatory. Teams can have any number of players, but should have at least 2 lines (8 players). Age range preferred is 16 and up. \$80 dollar entry fee per team to help with tournament costs is due prior to your game start time. Each team will be approached prior to puck drop for entry fee.
- Games will consist of two 20 minute periods.
- Ice cleaning / flooding or sweeping will be conducted as required during the day.
- Heated tent is provided for people to put skates on, get ready or just to warm up.
- Fire pits and firewood provided by Triangle Construction.
- Hot dogs, hamburgers, and beverages will be available for purchase on site by Jorgy's Hotspot.
- Porta-Potties will be on site.

Fans and spectators are welcome to attend. Please bring lawn chairs and blankets.
