GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- No movement allowed without valid Road Protection Agreement in place.
- Permit is specific to the roads listed. Any other roads must be negotiated prior to travel.
- Permits **may** be issued for the movement of equipment on banned roads, at the discretion of the Public Works Superintendent or the Chief Administrative Officer.
- Permits may be extended at the discretion of the Public Works Superintendent or the Chief Administrative Officer and may be suspended if road conditions warrant.
- All operators on site must have a copy of this Permit and be prepared to present it upon demand to a Peace Officer.
- Tire chains are not allowed on Summer Village roads at any time.
- Metal track equipment is not allowed to walk down Summer Village roads or ditches at any time

Road Permit

- All mud tracked onto the road surface must be cleaned off. Permit holder may need to re-gravel the road after cleaning, in Aspen subdivision.
- No parking, loading or unloading of vehicles, trailers or equipment on Summer Village roads, shoulders or in the ditches.
- Must not delay/obstruct any other vehicles.
- **Notify the Summer Village immediately if road surface or road condition starts to deteriorate.**

SPECIFIC RESTRICTIONS:

Only early morning arrival and early morning departure
